- To develop new capacity
- To fill-in the gap
- To extend EU Integration studies to new areas
- To enrich existing curricula



Jean Monnet Chairs

- Full-time teaching posts in EU studies
- University professors/senior lecturers
- Deepening teaching in EU studies
- Supervising researches in EU studies
- Mentoring young generation of teachers and researchers ...



Jean Monnet Centres of Excellence

- Focal point of competence and knowledge on European Union subjects
- Guidance and vision to create synergies among the best experts in EU studies
- Research function (lead research)
- Teaching function (develop content and tools on EU subjects to update current courses and curricula)
- Promoting debate and producing publications
- Pooling resources: human and documentary resources



Jean Monnet Networks

- Focal point of competence and knowledge on European Union subjects at international level
- Creation and development of consortia of international players (HEIs, Centres of Excellence, Chairs, Modules, departments in European Studies, etc.)
- Existing networks integrating new members, young professionals, etc.
- Exchanging knowledge and expertise among members
- Enhancing cooperation



Jean Monnet Projects

- Innovation
 - Testing new methodologies
 - Curricula for students non-traditionally EU-studies faculties (consumer protection, health care/medicine, etc.)
 - Virtual classroom
 - Provision of activities related to EU for primary, secondary, vocational schools
- Cross-fertilisation
- Spreading content

Jean Monnet Networks (example 1)

- Subject: "European identity, culture, exchanges and multilingualism"
- Three dimensions of European Identity:
 - A) European identity and citizenship among <u>students</u> studying courses in the area of EU Studies (better knowledge → deeper identify?)
 - B) Identities in urban contexts (European multilingual city → feeling and understanding deeper the European identity?)
 - C) Emerging new European young researchers' identities (exchanges and doctoral studies as a way to promote European dimension)
- Becoming a reference point for researchers in EU-related themes addressing young scholars and doctorate students in the process of developing their theses



Jean Monnet Networks (example 2)

- Subject: "More EU"
- Objective: Promoting outreach to enhance knowledge of EU in five capitals where there are high percentage of Euro-sceptics
- Actions:
 - European Awareness Day;
 - Seminar with public admin officials;
 - Academic conferences;
 - Webinar for high school teachers;
 - Webpage, social media, newsletters, youtube channel, European Civic Education course delivered as MOOC.



Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence

- Creating a centre of Excellence in a geographically specific context (western border region of Hungary) and for peculiar target regions (disadvantaged regions);
- Promoting multi-stakeholders debates on challenges of European Integration in an increasingly competitive, globalised world and Europe's role in the world;
- Enhancing regional cooperation and integration through exchanges between institutions of HE in new member states and new EU neighbourhoods.
